
English Extra Summer Programme

This is the perfect balance of serious study in language competency, but the opportunity to explore the UK and make new friends in the afternoons with lots of sporting, cultural and artistic activities.

Lessons are held every morning from 09.00 - 12.15 in internationally mixed classes of no more than 12 students per class and will focus on all four skills of reading, writing, speaking and listening. With small classes, students will have ample opportunity to practice their communication skills as we put a big emphasis on speaking. Students will find that even during a short amount of time, they will experience the full immersion into the language and make good progress.

There will be afternoon and evening activities including sports, visits to local places of interest, cultural activities and of course joining in on our big Friday BBQ in the garden! There is one afternoon free a week for free time.

Standard homestay is included in the price of the package and is half board on weekdays and full board on weekends. Individually travelling students will be the only student of their native tongue in the house.

Your mornings (09.00 - 12.15) will be spent working on all four skills of reading, writing, speaking and listening in classes of no more than 12 students per class. Classes will be internationally mixed.

The afternoons (13.30 - 15.00) will be spent either on conversation classes or you can choose to join in on our Academic English programme where you can study towards exams like IELTS as well as academic study skills like critical thinking and essay writing.

Don't worry though, there's plenty of time for fun. You can join us for evening activities, our Friday BBQ and our Saturday excursions!

Homestay Accommodation and Welfare

Questions for Parents

Staying with a host family is one of the most important parts of a student's stay, no matter how old they are, everyone wants to stay somewhere that is value for money, with a caring family and good company.

It's a vital part of improving a language learner's social English and means they need to continue their learning and speaking English once the classes are finished.

With that in mind, individually travelling students are the only native speaker of their language with their host family and in groups, it's a twin stay. It's the full immersion experience in practice.



Will my child be safe in Cheltenham?

Yes they will be safe with us. Cheltenham is a very safe place as it is an affluent area with low crime rates and friendly local people.

Although people should always be careful and aware of their surroundings, it is a place that has been voted as one of the safest university towns in the UK (2013) and we have many individuals and groups returning each year because they feel safe and secure here.

What if my child doesn't like their host family?

It's hard when you first arrive somewhere, everything feels so new and it may take a week or two to settle in if a child is shy. With our experienced hosts, they understand all of this and all they want is for the student to be relaxed and happy in their new home.

We visit our host families regularly so that we completely understand their family situation and suitability for looking after students and we try to pair students to families based on requirements. It helps as well if the student is in contact with the family before their arrival so they can get to know each other a little bit.

If for any reason the student is unhappy with their family, we will arrange another host family at a cost of £40, but if the family have fallen short of the quality standard that we would expect, we will find another host family as soon as possible for free. Communication is the most important thing!

Can I come too?

We would be delighted to accept you as a student for yourself at inlingua Cheltenham. We will make sure that you will be in a different class to your child in a General or Business English course.

If you do not wish to take a course, then we are happy to help you find accommodation, either with your child or without. We can arrange host family accommodation for family members if required. Ask us for more information.




Standard Homestay

Our host families love meeting new people from all over the world.

Standard homestay is half board accommodation from Monday to Friday and full board at the weekends.

Accommodation is in a single room and you will share the rest of the house as a member of the family. Many of our families are within walking distance of the school and some by bus. The furthest accommodation is 20 minutes by bus.



Executive Homestay

Executive Homestay offer private bathroom facilities which are either en-suite or the student has sole use of the facilities. Accommodation is offered on a half board arrangement on weekdays and full board on weekends. Full board is available upon request.

Thanks to the close relationship we have with our host families, we can offer high quality homestay accommodation to suit your needs.

You will be within walking distance of the school or a short bus ride. The furthest accommodation is 20 minutes by bus.
